

The Heart

Psalm 7:10- My defence is of God, which saveth the upright in heart. (KJV)

Care and attention to the heart are central in the serious life with the Lord God. God is dominant in the hearts of serious believers during the course of earthly life. Serious believers work to expel from the heart all that is not of the Lord God. Filling the heart with the Lord God brings abundant joy to the Lord's faithful.

Psalm 9:1- I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvellous works. (KJV)

Developing humility in the heart is fostered by prayer, fasting and repentance.

Psalm 13:5- But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation. (KJV)

Vileness, arrogance and judgment of others have no place in believers' hearts. Firmly trusting with faith in the Lord God benefits the heart beyond measure. The heart's contents are revealed in the believer's daily personal relationships. Charity abounds in daily interactions when love is paramount in the heart. The heart's full capability is a great mystery known only to the Lord God.

Psalm 15:2- He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart. (KJV)

Courage arising in the heart in times of great adversity makes a difference. The Lord sparks the heart's actions at critical moments in the believer's life. Defining words of necessity arise in the believer's heart at life's critical times. Placing the heart's trust in the Lord God is always the wisest course of action. The heart attains peace beyond understanding when filled with love of God.
