God's Power to Heal

Matthew 15:30-And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: (KJV)

The Lord God's power to heal is well-documented in the Holy Scriptures. Persons with various afflictions, illnesses and injuries do well to seek healing. Turning to the Lord God in strong faith and hope makes a decided difference. Healing will take various forms with healing of the soul being most important. Peace overcomes the believer when the soul is cleansed and healed of afflictions.

Mark 1:34-And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him. (KJV) Repentance, Holy Confession, Holy Communion and Holy Unction bring healing. The hunger in the soul seeks healing of soul and body throughout earthly life. Healing by the Lord God results in joy and peace to the fervent believer's soul. Seekers of healing do well to search the Scriptures to learn about God's power. The Holy Scriptures provide multiple examples of Jesus Christ's healing power. Luke 17:15-And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, (KJV)

Glorifying the Lord God when healings occur is a way to demonstrate gratitude. The believer has a responsibility to thank the Lord when healing takes place. God knows whether the believer is genuinely grateful for healing taking place. Healings from illnesses lead to behavioral change and God being glorified. Others persons benefit when believers share stories of their personal healings.

John 5:13- And he that was healed wist not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in that place (KUV)

The Church truthfully proclaims the Gospel accounts of God's healing power. Attentive listeners take the Gospel accounts of healing to heart and embrace them. Gospel accounts of God's healings provide hope for persons faced with suffering. Having firm hope in the Lord God is important if healing from suffering is desired. The soul can be healed even when the body is well-beyond being restored

James 5:16-Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. (KJV)

Prayers to God for persons suffering and in need of healing are very beneficial. Persons suffering draw strength from caring believers' prayers for their healing. It is important that individuals who are suffering do not feel alone in their situation. Persons suffering from despondency and despair benefit from prayers of believers. God loves each person and is immediately within reach through personal prayer.
