

Lord Have Mercy

Psalm 6:2-Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed. (KJV)

Consistently seeking the Lord God's mercy is beneficial throughout earthly life. Believers act wisely when recognizing the need for God's healing and mercy. Psalm 123:2-Behold, as the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; so our eyes wait upon the LORD our God, until that he have mercy upon us. (KJV)
