The Paths of Life

Psalm 16:11- Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore. (KJV)

Believers are required to make decisions throughout daily life for their salvation. Responsible decision-making begins when the mind begins functioning well.
