

The Power of His Name

Ephesians 5:20-Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (KJV_

The Holy Apostle Paul references the power of Jesus' Name in his Epistles. The use of Jesus' Name in daily life requires constant and careful consideration. Divine power and authority exist in the prayerful expression of Jesus' Name. The depth of the believer's faith is revealed when Jesus' Name is expressed. The believer's motivation eventually becomes known when Jesus' Name is uttered. Prayerful outcomes are normally desired when the believer uses Jesus' Name.

Philippians 2:10-That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; (KJV_

The Holy Apostle Paul describes the far-reaching nature and effect of Jesus' Name. The power and effects of Jesus' Name exceed human measurement capabilities. Believers are at best humbled, in awe and grateful when using Jesus' Name. Deep introspection has a place in the believer's normal use of Jesus' Name. Jesus' Name is not to be cast about carelessly or expressed in a casual fashion. Honorable purposes are intended in the normal daily use of Jesus' Name.

Colossians 3:7-And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him. (KJV_

Jesus' Name empowers and guides believers in the most difficult times. The Name of Jesus is to be said with great love, honor and clear purpose. The soul is placed in peril when Jesus' Name is expressed with any disdain. Jesus' Name is the essential foundation for the believer's thoughts and actions. Seekers of God's Heavenly Kingdom and eternal life use Jesus' Name with care. The use of Jesus' Name enables believers to overcome obstacles in daily life.

2 Thessalonians 1:12-That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. (KJV_

Jesus' Name is well- applied in seeking healing and solutions to life's challenges. Glorifying Jesus' Name in daily behavior is healthy for personal relationships. The believer's unity with Jesus Christ is reflected in the way Jesus' Name is used. Serious believers manifest love for Jesus Christ when expressing Jesus' Name. The desire to glorify Jesus' Name in daily life is strong for serious believers. Serious believers seek to fully embrace Jesus' Name in the heart, mind and soul.
