

God is Our Nourishment

Jeremiah 15:16-Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts. (KJV)

The Lord God is our sustenance, our nourishment for life and life eternal. Humans hunger for the nourishment coming from God to satisfy the soul. The world attempts unsuccessfully to satisfy the soul with various alternatives. Only the Lord is the Source of the soul's authentic food providing satisfaction. Hunger in the soul is fully and consistently addressed by turning to the Lord God.

Matthew 4:4-But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. (KJV)

Believers need only reach out in faith to the Lord seeking sustenance for the soul. The Church offers guidance for believers to learn more about the food from God.
