John 3:21- But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. (KJV)

Tellers of truth in the ways pleasing to the Lord become firmly rooted in God.

Being a teller of truth in today's world requires confidence in the value of truth.

Truth is synonymous with Jesus Christ and is to be embraced by believers.
